Considering the space constraints in Mumbai, the toilet was converted into a plush powder room. With smart sense of design, the use of dark colours enhance the aesthetics of a rather tiny space. Carefully handcrafted organic fixtures and wall art are used alongside the black marble cladding, which strikes a fine balance with the subtle champagne gold textured ceiling.



The smart placement of mirrors and golden inserts ensures that the black, white and gold remain in vision throughout the user. Smart luxury design with metal inlays for a high-end feel and creating an impact as soon as one enters the powder room.

Feeling contemporary design vibes with a touch of quirky and classical design, this is what the washroom at 145 Kansa Mills is all about. Starting from the entrance door of the wash room lobby that has a geometric patterned door with coloured glass inserts in it, right down to the wooden slatted ceiling and chevron wooden flooring as well as the peppy blue laminate finish washroom doors with 'Gents' and 'Ladies' plaques placed on the doors.

Each ladies washroom is lined in tiles with round frames of classical style mosaic-style paintings from ceiling to floor, and the flooring is done in textured blue tiles. In keeping with the trend, there is one white washroom provided with one 'Gents' alone and two 'Ladies' washrooms - each of them following the same quirky and upbeat design pattern with period porcelain tiles, round seating and blue floors.
